Cover: The posters reproduced on the cover of this issue illustrate a few of the patriotic services undertaken by young men after the American entry into World War I. Benjamin F. Shearer discusses an almost forgotten branch of wartime activity in his article "An Experiment in Military and Civilian Education: The Students' Army Training Corps at the University of Illinois." The SATC was inaugurated at hundreds of campuses around the country at the start of the fall, 1918, term.
